(Narrator): Our moon is a large space object that orbits the earth. Like the earth, the moon has many mountains and craters, or holes. At night, the moon shines because it reflects sunlight like a mirror. Although they are close to each other, the moon and the earth have many differences.

The moon is smaller than the earth, and its gravity is weaker. Gravity is an invisible force that pulls us toward the earth and keeps us from floating into space. If you were on the moon, you would weigh less and could jump farther.

On the moon, there is no air to breathe or to carry sound, so it is completely silent. It never rains or snows on the moon.
