People have been making popcorn for thousands of years. It is believed that making popcorn originated in Mexico. Native American tribes began making it as well and introduced it to European settlers. It was not only eaten, but popcorn was even worn as jewelry or used for decoration.

What makes popcorn pop? There is a drop of water inside each popcorn kernel. When the water heats up, it turns to steam, and it begins to fill the kernel. The inside of the kernel gets bigger, and the hard outside shell pops open. The kernel is turned inside out, and the popcorn is ready to eat. Most popcorn comes in two basic shapes when it is popped: snowflake, which is bigger, and mushroom, which does not crumble as easily.
