Listening Scripts

(Narrator): Listen to a passage about making a piñata. You will answer questions 1 and 2 based on this passage.

(Pause 2 seconds.)

(Narrator): You can do a lot of fun craft projects, such as making a piñata, with your family or friends. Piñatas are decorated containers filled with candy and small toys that are broken and shared during celebrations.

Materials:

Cardboard or foam

Paper (tissue paper, newspaper, and construction paper)

Paint or markers

Scissors

Glue or tape

Candy and small toys to fill the piñata

String

Stick (to hit the piñata)

Procedure:

First, think of the shape you want to create, for example, an animal or movie character.

Second, use the scissors to cut the cardboard or foam to create your shape.

Then, use the paper, paint, or markers to decorate your piñata.

Next, when the paint is dry, create an opening to fill it with candy and small toys.

After filling the piñata, seal the opening with glue or tape.

Finally, make a hole at the top of your piñata and attach a string to hang it.

Remember to practice safety measures and ask an adult for help. Enjoy your piñata!

(Narrator): Now answer the following questions.

(Pause 2 seconds.)

(Narrator): Look for question number 1. Now listen carefully to the question.

(Narrator): Based on the selection, why is it important to wait **BEFORE** filling the piñata?

(Narrator): Now listen carefully to the question.

(Narrator): According to the sentences, why are deserts dry areas?

(Pause 2 seconds.)

(Note: Pause 2 seconds between options.)

(Narrator):

- A. Deserts are known for their sandy soil.
- B. Deserts have minimal vegetation.
- C. Deserts lack moisture.
